## How we prevent abuse, neglect and victimization

CCCC's services are home-based and include:

- Parenting education
- Domestic abuse counseling
- Youth leadership, empowerment and violence prevention services and education
- Counseling for child witnesses of domestic violence and child survivors of sexual abuse
- Crime victim advocacy
- Family literacy groups and empowerment groups for abused women and child witnesses of family violence

## Who we serve

Children, youth and families in the greater New Haven area including:

- Children who have been physically or sexually abused, neglected or who have witnessed domestic abuse
- Infants and toddlers at-risk for child abuse or neglect
- Youth at-risk of school drop-out, violent behaviors or teen pregnancy
- Parents who have histories of mental illness, domestic violence, substance abuse or homelessness
- Adults who are victims of elder abuse, robbery, assault and hate and bias crimes

### What is the Adopt a Family Program?

The Adopt a Family program is an annual community effort to support families who are struggling. Families, businesses, faith organizations and other community groups “**adopt a family**” or “**child**”.

### How does it work?

Individuals or donating groups are given information about a particular family whose lives they can brighten with holiday gifts. Children's ages and gender, along with specific needs and gift requests, are provided to donors. The donors then shop for this family's holiday gifts. Many adopting groups also give stocking items and decorations. This giving choice allows you to know that you have helped a particular, although anonymous, family. We do ask that all donations be new.
